## US resolutions passed



The list includes:

- More than 30 **cities** throughout the U.S. Cities including New York, Washington DC, Chicago, Boston, Seattle, Minneapolis and St Paul, Detroit, Pittsburgh, Baltimore, Cleveland, San Francisco and other Bay Area cities, Sacramento, Hartford.
- State **legislatures** in Minnesota, Michigan, Illinois and Alabama
- **Labor** organizations including the National Union of Healthcare Workers, the National Black Worker Center, the UE national convention, the ILWU international convention, the IBU Pacific, the California Federation of Labor, California Nurses Association, Washington State Labor Council and 14 local labor councils.

In June 2023 the **New York City** Council unanimously passed a resolution calling upon the Biden administration to end the policy of draconian economic sanctions against Cuba, and as an immediate step to remove Cuba from the State Department's list of countries that are State Sponsors of Terrorism (SSOT). In May 2023 **Washington DC**'s council had unanimously passed a similar resolution.

**100** such resolutions have, during the last few years, been passed in city councils, county boards, state legislatures, central labor councils and union branches. In total the organizations that have passed resolutions encompass populations in excess of **54 million people**.

The Biden administration has maintained almost all of the 243 blockade tightening policies of the Trump administration including keeping Cuba on the State Sponsors of Terrorism List with no justification – ignoring the voices of 54 million Americans. Meanwhile the Republican Party in Congress is taking steps to permanently include Cuba in the SSOT list beyond presidential control – through introducing bills known as the FORCE Act H.R.314 and S.538.
